# **Green Light New York**



On June 17, 2019, Governor Andrew Cuomo signed the Green Light bill, which grants driver's licenses for ALL New Yorkers! The passage of this bill is a win for the safety of all New Yorkers. We are all safer when ALL drivers are properly licensed, tested, and insured. Hardworking immigrants will now be able to access a driver's license to drive to work or take their children to school without fear that a minor stop could lead to detention or even deportation.

Throughout 2018, Neighbors Link worked closely with the Green Light NY Coalition. We are extremely grateful to all the advocates who attended rallies and to all the elected officials who championed this bill.





In 2019, we were also selected to be part of the **Liberty Defense Project Rapid Response Program** to provide dedicated attorneys to assist immigrants in urgent, timesensitive legal jeopardy.

The law only allows a few categories of people to qualify and for those who are eligible, it can often take several years to complete the process. # **Building Trust, Breaking Stereotypes**








Government Grants 10%


